



Instructions for Recommenders for Degree Plus Scholarship Application

Thank you for your interest in providing a recommendation for someone who is interested in receiving financial assistance for a Degree Plus certificate at the University of Utah. Instructions for recommendations:

- 1. The best recommendation letters include personal observations about the applicant attesting to qualities such as professionalism, ethics, teamwork, creativity, leadership or tenacity.
- 2. Make sure to include how you know the applicant and for how long you've known the applicant.
- 3. You recommendation can be included in the body of an e-mail or as an attached document.
- 4. Recommendations will not be shared with applicants unless prior, written authorization is received from the recommender.
- 5. Please include your contact information and as appropriate, title or place of work if that's relevant to your recommendation.
- 6. There is no minimum or maximum word count for the recommendations.
- 7. Deadlines for scholarship applications are August 1st for fall semester programs and November 1st for spring semester programs.
